VeriScan vs. Intellicheck

About Intellicheck

Intellicheck, formerly known as Intellicheck Mobilisa, has been in the identity validation industry for over two decades. Intellicheck is a publicly traded company (Nasdaq: IDN) headquartered in Melville, New York, and is an industry leader in identity verification within the law enforcement sector.

Key Differences

Intellicheck currently uses a hardware-free business model, limiting the methods of implementation and often relying on end-user's personal devices for ID validation. Because Intellicheck is hardware free, the solutions are not capable of authenticating identity documents under UV and IR light, or reading microprint, which are common signs of fraudulence, especially on AI-generated IDs.

Intellicheck software also works via SDK - data can be sent into compatible software, but there is no visitor management platform or backend application where scan results can be viewed or exported. Because of this, Intellicheck is often licensed inside other platforms as part of their intake process, so many end customers may not even realize that their ID verification is powered by Intellicheck.

In contrast, VeriScan works both as an integrated solution, passing data through into your core systems, or as a standalone visitor management system. It offers WYSIWYG data retention settings that can be built without coding or integration, ensuring ultimate compliance across your business.

The pricing models are also notably different, with Intellicheck charging transaction rates per scan and requiring minimum monthly scan volumes. VeriScan software is priced on a per month or annual basis, with no limitations on number of scans.

ID Authentication

Intellicheck's authentication solutions rely on barcode validation, OCR, and third party database queries. VeriScan's ID authentication solutions rely on barcode validation and OCR, as well as forensic document examination under multiple light wavelengths and microprint reading. While VeriScan also offers third party database checks, this process allows for documents to be authenticated with a high degree of accuracy, without the added cost of the database queries.

Authentication hardware

ID authentication requires specialty hardware, and a Windows computer with sufficient processing power for high speed image analysis.

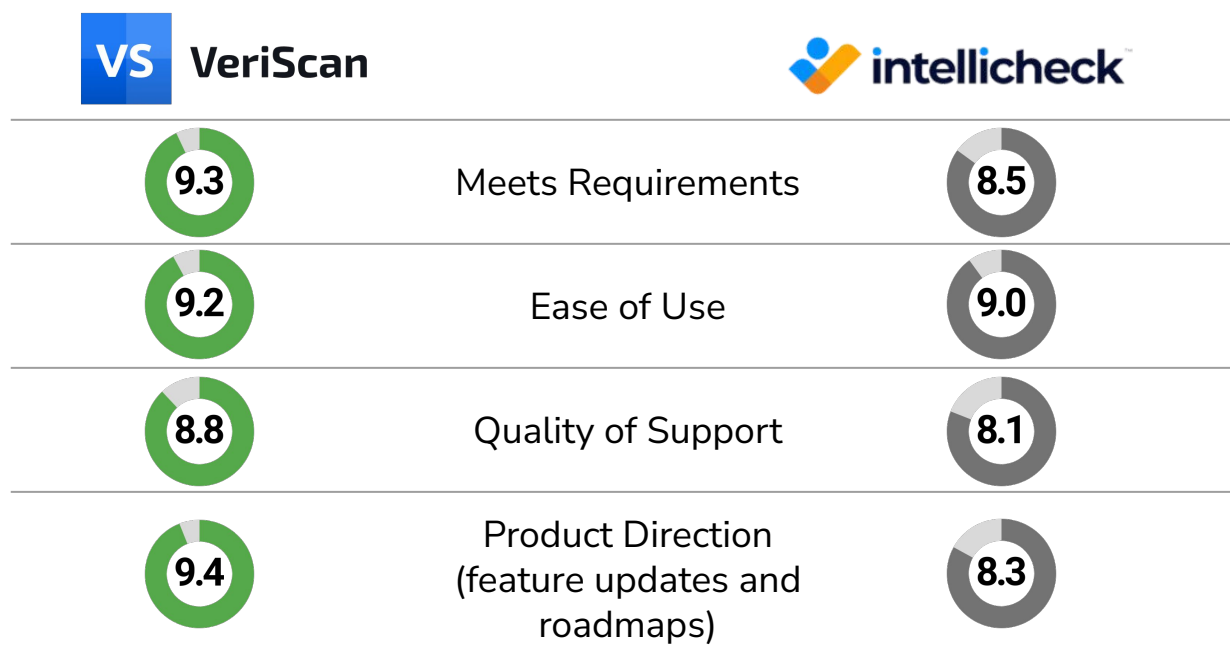

VeriScan is compatible with best-in-class hardware built by organizations such as Thales and E-Seek, while Intellicheck relies primarily on smartphone cameras or barcode scanners.

Comparison Testing

We tested 80 known fake IDs against Intellicheck's barcode scanning. The scanner performed well overall, catching the majority (56%) of fake IDs tested. Our tests showed that while Intellicheck's barcode algorithms can catch up to 100% of fake IDs from certain states, there are major weaknesses in catching fraudulent documents from Nevada and California, where Intellicheck missed 90% and 64.3% of fakes, respectively, and the software missed about half of fake IDs from Ohio, Arizona, and Maryland.

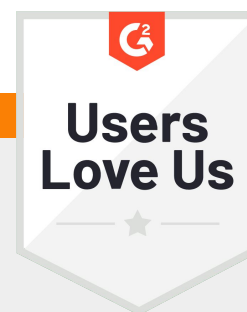
Conclusion

VeriScan and Intellicheck are market leaders for remote ID authentication, offering the strongest solutions for verification of IDs via smartphone.

VeriScan is a stronger choice for businesses looking to reduce fraud, as it catches fake IDs with a high degree of accuracy, while Intellicheck's market share is more focused on time-saving and hardware-free Id scanning.

VeriScan also offers a backend, visitor management system with comprehensive PII and privacy settings, as well as detailed reporting, while Intellicheck only offers a few standard options for data retention and reporting. For this reason, Intellicheck works best when embedded into existing software applications and is not ideal for standalone businesses, or organizations which need greater control over their flow of data,
