# VeriScan vs. Minor Decliner

## About Minor Decliner

Minor Decliner is an age verification technology provider. The small business is headquartered in Stevensville, MD and was founded in 2016. They sell handheld and countertop ID checkers with an emphasis on ID scanning for age verification.

## Key Differences

Minor Decliner is largely used for verifying the age and expiration date on an identity document. Their primary function is simply verifying the age on the ID, with little ability to detect or flag fraudulent documents. In contrast, VeriScan verifies document authenticity, as well as age and expiration.

Minor Decliner relies solely on 2D barcode scanning for all fake ID detection, including their Intellicheck-powered solution, while VeriScan offers full document authentication that includes over 400 AI-powered security checks, including OCR, crossmatching and UV/IR/White light checks.

Another key difference between the two offerings is that Minor Decliner's software is limited to a few proprietary hardware options. VeriScan can pair with a wide variety of ID scanners and is also available hardware-free as an app available for both Android and iOS. VeriScan is also available through API and SDK, making it easy to integrate with existing software.

VeriScan also offers a full visitor management platform, allowing users to create and manage lists, send email or SMS alerts, add agreements and waivers, and more from a cloud-based, user friendly dashboard. Minor Decliner does keep record of ID scans, but does not offer visitor management.

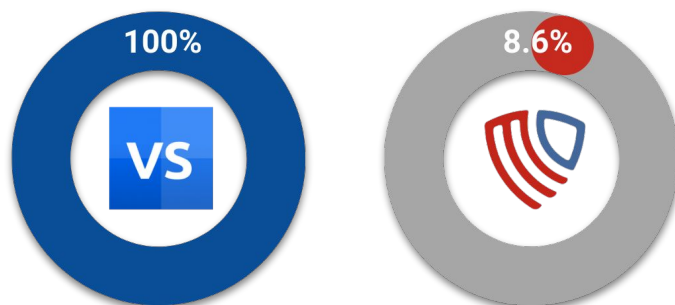
# VeriScan vs. Minor Decliner

## Testing with 150 fake IDs

We tested 150 known fake IDs using both VeriScan and Minor Decliner's base-level mobile ID scanning solutions.

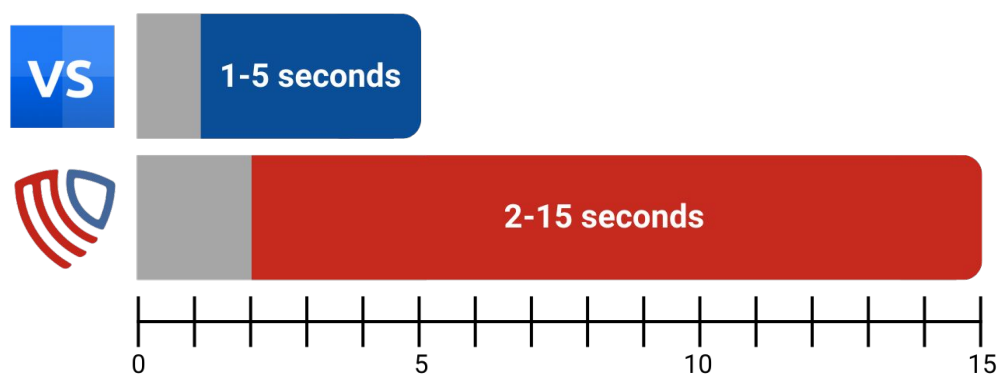
While Minor Decliner was capable of flagging expired IDs, VeriScan caught 100% of the fake IDs tested, where Minor Decliner only flagged 8.6%. While both providers have options for higher-level fake ID detection, VeriScan vastly outperforms Minor Decliner while using only a handheld ID scanner.

### Fake IDs Caught



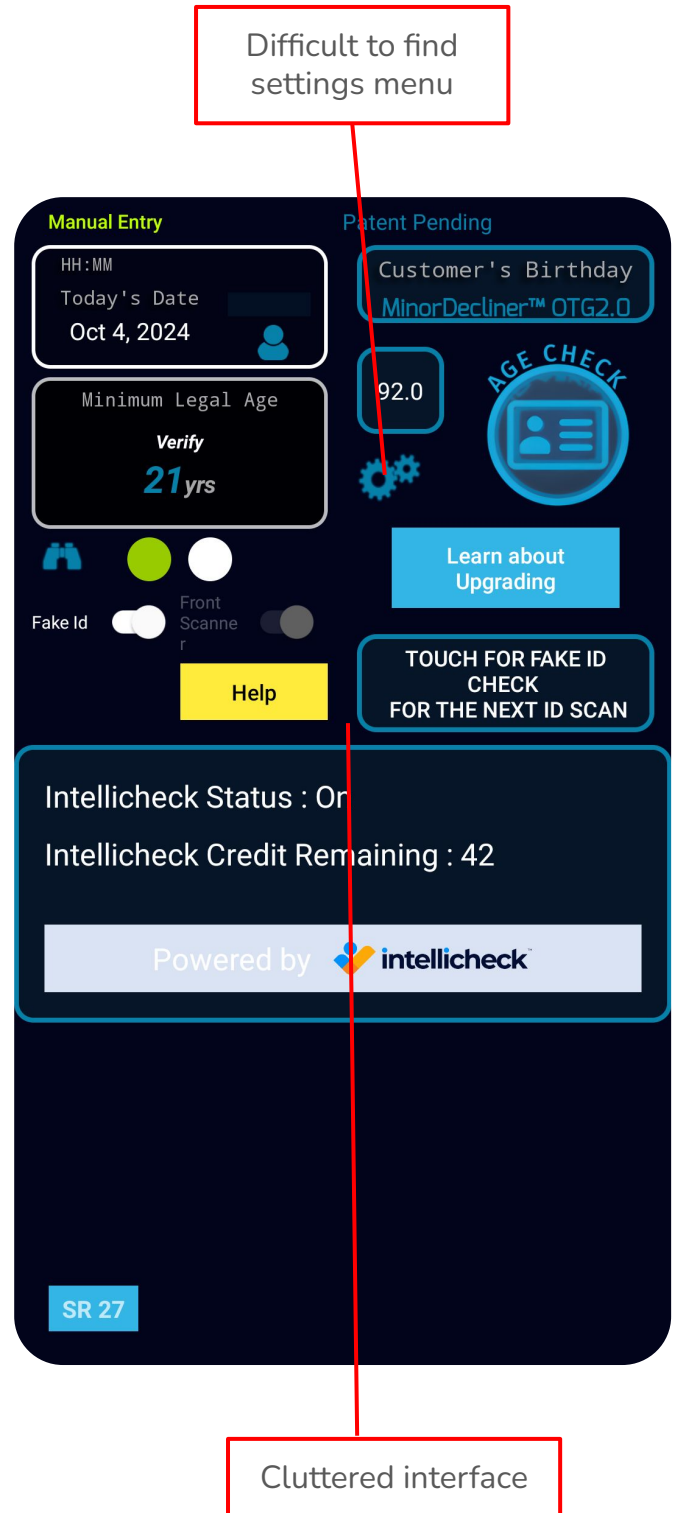
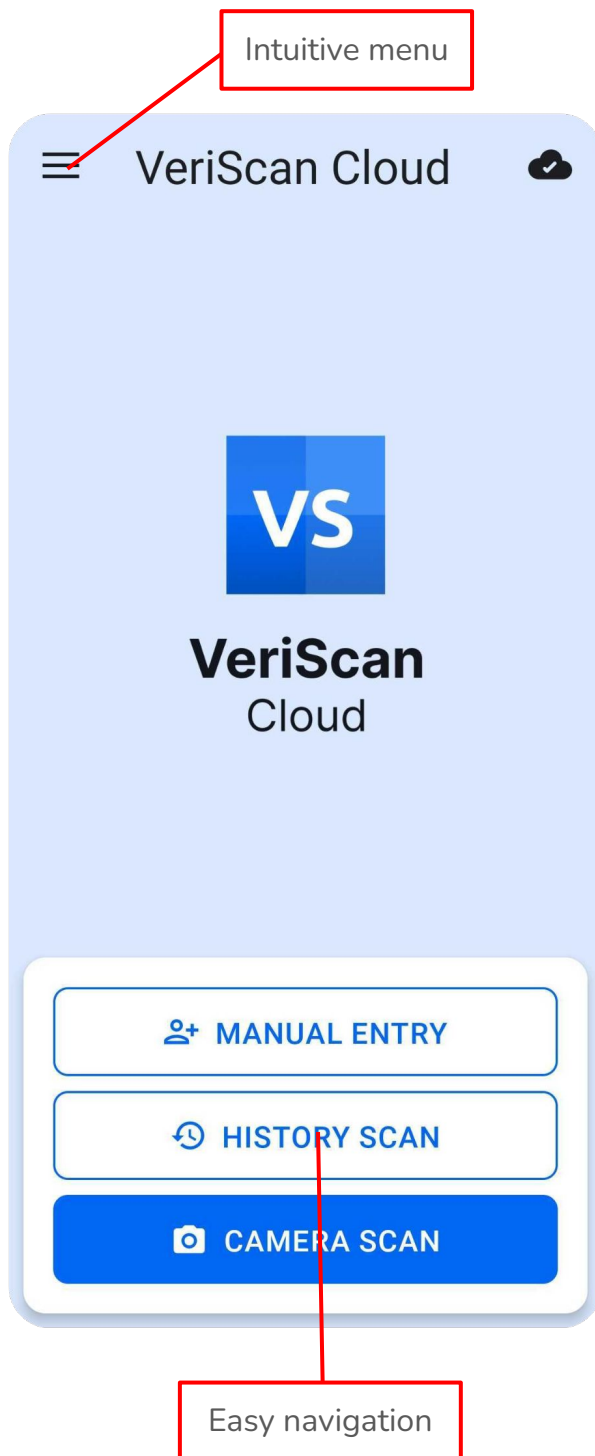
Lighting also had a large effect on the Minor Decliner scanner performance. In a brightly lit environment, scans took between 2-15 seconds, but in regular, indoor light about half of the IDs could not be read. VeriScan was able to read all IDs in 1-5 seconds in both types of lighting tested.

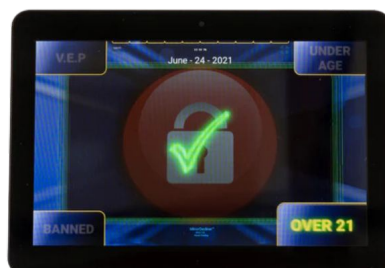
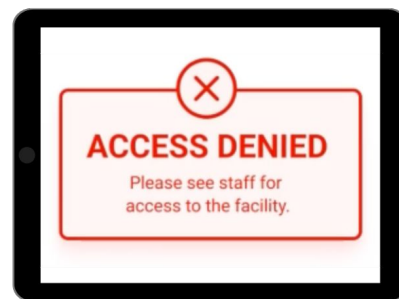
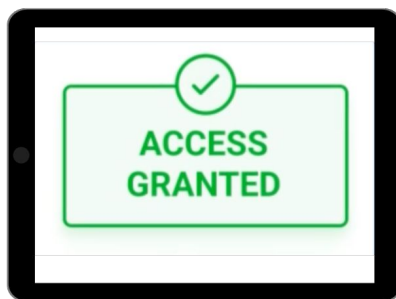

## Access control solutions

VeriScan and Minor Decliner both offer solutions that allow for unattended access control to age restricted areas via electronic door lock. While there are a few differences between VeriScan and Minor Decliner's solutions, the primary one is that VeriScan offers fake ID detection and visitor management with a cloud-based admin portal.

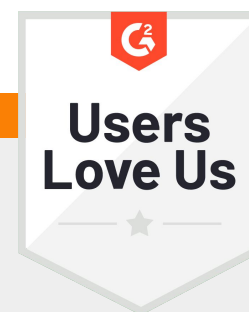
# VeriScan vs. Minor Decliner

## Conclusion

Minor Decliner is a sufficient solution for businesses looking for low cost ID scanning with no compliance, PII, or privacy needs. However, for businesses who are looking to prevent ID fraud, VeriScan is the better option. While both solutions offer document expiration and age verification, all VeriScan solutions are able to catch fake IDs.

VeriScan also offers full document authentication with no cost-per-scan, using over 400 AI-powered security checks to detect up to 95% of fake IDs, where Minor Decliner's Intellicheck-powered fake ID detection only uses the document's barcode to flag fraudulent documents.
